## 3.4.3 Number of extension and outreach programs conducted by the institution through organized forums including NSS/NCC with involvement of community during the last five years

Smt. Sushiladevi Deshmukh Senior College, Latur, has a longstanding tradition of engaging in community service and social responsibility. Over the past five years, the college has conducted numerous extension and outreach programs through various organized forums, including the National Service Scheme (NSS) and other departmental initiatives. These programs have not only addressed critical community needs but have also fostered a sense of social responsibility and civic engagement among students. The following is a detailed account of the extension and outreach activities conducted by the institution from 2018 to 2023, highlighting the number of programs, their objectives, and their impact on both the community and the students.

In 2018, the college organized a diverse array of activities aimed at enhancing community welfare and student development. One of the significant initiatives was the Self-Defence Workshop, organized by Yuvati Mandal and NSS in collaboration with Dayanand College. This workshop aimed to equip students, particularly young women, with essential self-defense skills to ensure their personal safety and empowerment. The training boosted participants' confidence and self-reliance, fostering a sense of security and preparedness.

Another key activity was the Self-Defence Training Workshop, also organized by Yuvati Mandal and NSS. The college also organized multiple Blood Donation Camps through the NSS Department. In response to the devastating floods in Kerala, the NSS organized the Kerala Relief Fund Rally. The lecture series helped in broadening the academic horizons of participants and promoting a culture of continuous learning.

A notable initiative of the Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was the Career Development Program. In collaboration with the District AIDS Prevention and Control Team and the District Surgeon Latur, the NSS Department organized a Quiz Competition focused on HIV/AIDS, Blood Donation, and Tuberculosis (TB). Safe and Home Safe Health Check-Up Camp, which provided health screenings and

awareness programs for women's health and safety.

In early 2023, the Geography Department organized a Workshop on "Road Safety - Saving Life" in collaboration with the Regional Transport Office (RTO), Latur, and State Road Safety Mission. This workshop aimed to raise awareness about road safety measures and educate participants on practices to prevent accidents and ensure safe road usage.

The NSS Department and Political Science organized "A Collective Vote of Allegiance to Democracy", an event to promote civic engagement and celebrate the principles of democracy. This event encouraged students to reflect on the importance of democratic values and active citizenship.

The extensive range of activities organized by the college in 2018 to 2023 highlights its role as a vibrant centre for learning, community service, and student development.
